


#### **VEHICLE PREPARATION**

#### **GENERAL**

1. Shift vehicle transmission into PARK. Turn key to OFF position and remove from vehicle.


#### **GRILLE REMOVAL**

 Carefully push down on two tabs to disengage grille from front fascia. Tilt top outward to remove from vehicle.




#### **ACCESSORY INSTALLATION**


1. Remove and retain two fasteners to remove front winch cover.




2. Place support bracket ④ onto front suspension mount. Pass two fasteners ⑥ though bracket and mount.




3. Pass nut-plate ② through front suspension mount and align with fasteners installed in previous step.




4. Thread two fasteners 6 into weld nuts 2.





5. Install front of support bracket with two fasteners6 and two nuts 8.






6. Torque two fasteners **(6)** to specification.






7. Carefully reach through wheel well and hook backer plate ③ onto bumper support.




8. Ensure backer plate is aligned with holes in bumper support.

#### TIP


Tape hook of backer plate to bumper support to prevent movement when installing bumper.



9. Reinstall winch cover with two retained fasteners.




10. Align bumper ① with upper and lower mounts.



11. Pass two fasteners ① through bumper and chassis. Secure fasteners with two nuts ⑧.


Do not torque fasteners at this time.



12. Secure lower bumper with two fasteners ⑤.


