



Installation is easier if the vehicle is clean and free of debris. For your safety, and to ensure a satisfactory installation, perform all installation steps correctly in the sequence shown.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Shift vehicle transmission into "PARK". Turn ignition switch to "OFF" position and remove key.
- 2. Remove seats (CREW: rear seats).

^{*} Tool requirement dependent on specific installation.

- 3. Install close-off extension panel.
 - a. Install close-off extension panel ② by inserting upper brackets ④ into ROPS cross-member.



b. Pivot extension panel ② forward into ROPS, then loosely install four screws ⑧ through panel into ROPS.



c. Using extension panel ② as template, mark five holes in existing vehicle close-off panel.


Remove extension panel, drill five 5/16 inch (8 mm) holes at marked locations, then reinstall extension panel using four screws (8) and five push pin rivets (7). Torque screws to specification.


Control drill depth to prevent damage to underlying structure or components.



- 4. Install rear panel.
 - a. Rotate two handles ® on rear panel ① to unlocked position (parallel with upper panel edge).




b. Install rear panel ① by inserting two lower brackets ② into ROPS cross-member. Pivot panel forward into ROPS, then rotate handles
® to locked position (perpendicular to upper roof edge) as shown.



- 5. Install retention clip to close-off extension panel.
 - a. Center retention clip ⑥ on ROPS crossmember, butted up to lower side of crossmember. Mark hole in close-off extension panel
 ②.

NOTE

Gap between clip and panel will be filled with spacer in Step c. below.




b. Drill 1/4 inch (6 mm) hole through close-off extension panel ② at marked location.

c. Install clip 6 to extension panel 2 using screw
3, nylon spacer 4, and nut 5. Torque to specification.

TORQUE

42 in. lbs. (4.7 Nm) ± 10%



6. Reinstall seats.

▲ WARNING

If transporting vehicle in non-enclosed trailer then the following two items are required:

- A windshield must be installed (sold separately), and be FULLY CLOSED and LOCKED.
- · The vehicle must FACE FORWARD.

If the above requirements are not met, then panel ① must be removed.

Failure to comply may allow airflow, vibration, or other factors to separate rear panel from vehicle and cause an accident, resulting in serious personal injury or death.
